- 3 pens is all you need
- Set of colored markers (not mini-sized or scented) or colored pencils
- 2 - 1 gallon freezer bags with your full name on it
- A few large rectangular-shaped erasers
- Your Summer Reading List printed out or handwritten
- 2 boxes of tissues to share with the class
- Art smock or old shirt (with name on the collar for art class)

Other:

*You will **NOT NEED**: liquid glue (it's too messy), mechanical pencils with refill lead (very distracting), a **large** pencil box (no room in the desk), or a backpack on wheels (don't fit in all lockers)
