EDUCATION REVENUES TO THE TOWN - EXPLANATORY NOTES

REVENUE FROM SOURCES OTHER THAN STATE OR FEDERAL:

- a. <u>Tuition Fees Regular:</u> \$37,000. Two full-time students from other communities are projected for 2020-21 at an estimated tuition of \$18,500 per student.
- b. <u>Rental of School Buildings:</u> \$50,000 This represents custodial overtime and maintenance received from individuals and organizations renting the schools.
- c. Other Revenue from Local Sources: \$7,500. Revenue received from vendor rebates and refunds.

REVENUE FROM STATE-FEDERAL SOURCES:

- a. <u>Education Cost Sharing Grant:</u> \$6,317,010. The 2020-21 funding is the proposed funding from the Governor's FY2020-FY2021 biennial budget.
- b. <u>Adult Education:</u> \$15,154. Connecticut General Statutes, Section 10-71 and 10-71a provide for partial reimbursement for state mandated courses. Historically grant estimates are based on a sliding scale of 0% (wealthiest town) to 65% (poorest town). Using **2018-19** reported data, it is anticipated that Simsbury will be reimbursed at 17.02% of its total adult education expenditures, but subject to a state-wide funding cap.
