





## Attendance at Part-Time and Full-Time Magnet and Out-of-District Programs

- October 1, 2021: 125 students at full-time programs outside of Simsbury.
  - This number is 16 less from October 1, 2020.
  - 75 of the 125 students (60%) enrolled attend K and PK programs.
  - *These students are not reflected in the October 1 count.*
- October 1, 2021: 7 students at part-time magnet and out of district programs.
  - This number is 3 more than October 1, 2020
  - *These students are reflected in the October 1 count.*



# Next Steps


- Submit 10/1 data to demographer


