

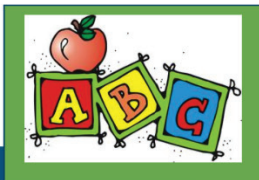

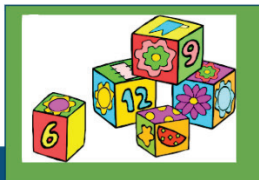

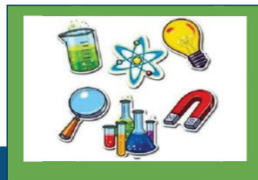
Literacy

Definition of Ethnicity Categories

Hispanic/Latino: A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Definition of Race Categories

American Indian/Alaskan Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment

Asian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam

Black/African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands

White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa

Federal Guidance Regarding Identification of Race/Ethnic Categories: Per federal guidelines, all students must be assigned to an ethnic and racial group for analysis purposes; therefore, all children must be identified answering Yes or No to the ethnicity question and by selecting one or more of the racial categories provided above. In the case of elementary and secondary students, if a parent or guardian will not select a category, appropriate school personnel should select a category for the student based on observation.
