### **REGISTRATION PROCEDURES**

When completed, the registration form should be mailed, along with a \$100.00 deposit **per child** deposit only needed when registering more than 1 month ahead) to the SEED office. A child *is enrolled* in SEED when all the required paperwork and registration fees are submitted to the SEED office, and any prior account is paid in full. A confirmation letter will be mailed to you.

# LATE START/EARLY RELEASE DAYS
