## **Workers' Compensation Medical Care Network Notice**

To All Board of Education Employees:

As your employer, we are committed to providing quality medical care for all employees injured in the course of their employment. Accordingly, we have secured the services of CIRMAnet Medical Care Plan to provide managed care services for all Workers' Compensation claims.

A Medical Care Plan has been filed with and approved by the State of Connecticut Workers Compensation Commission. A network of quality medical providers that includes physicians, chiropractors, family/general practice, internal medicine, neurology, optometrists, physical /occupational therapists, orthopedic surgery, and radiology, all of whom are committed to providing prompt, efficient care.

***Participation in the plan will be mandatory for all new injuries occurring on or after the effective date of the Medical Care Plan.*** Please note that for any recurrence of prior injuries, or for continuing treatment for injuries that occurred prior to the initiation of the Medical Care Plan, there will be no change. ***The effective date of the Medical Care Plan was November 24, 2014.***

Injured employees will be required to treat only with providers listed in the Medical Care Plan. If treatment occurs outside the Medical Care Plan, Workers' Compensation benefits shall be suspended (subject to the order of a Workers' Compensation Commissioner.) However, the employee can select any provider on the list of approved Workers' Compensation providers in a specialty not covered by the Medical Care Plan. A list of covered specialists will be provided as necessary.

***As in the past, you must immediately report all work-related injuries to your supervisor.*** Please be sure to adhere to the proper procedures if injured on the job in order to guarantee quality medical care and proper compensation. Your cooperation with this program will ensure compliance with Workers' Compensation regulations and reduce excessive costs while at the same time employees will continue to receive quality medical care.
