

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have received a considerable response to the survey sent out on Monday. In order to give everyone the opportunity to respond, we want to remind you that the survey closes tomorrow at 4:30 p.m. Below is the communication that was sent on Monday relative to the survey

As communicated in the letter from Superintendent Curtis last week, we are planning to resume learning in our K-12 school buildings for the 2020-21 school year in a manner that protects the health and safety of our students and staff. The results from this questionnaire will provide us preliminary numbers when determining capacity for each school and will assist us in our planning to best meet the needs of our students when we reopen in August.

Be assured all reopening decisions will be made in compliance with the Governor's and Commissioner's guidelines received on Monday, June 30th and will be made in collaboration with local and state health officials. All health and safety guidelines / protocols are of the utmost importance and will be followed as we reopen schools in August.

In our planning, your decision as a parent/ guardian is critical. You are not committing yourself to these options as we understand your situation may change. This response will be used for planning purposes only. However, we will ask you again in early August in order to confirm the number of in-school and out-of-school students K-12.

The questionnaire will be closed at 4:30 on Friday, July 10, 2020. Please complete one questionnaire per child by July 10th.
