

Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am writing to clarify changes to our school calendar. Although, Governor Lamont signed an executive order modifying the state law requiring that schools be in session for 180 days, it includes the caveat that you must go to school through June 30th before the 180 day waiver is applied. As a result of the upcoming two week closure, the last day of school will be Friday, June 26th. At this point graduation is still scheduled on Friday, June 12th.

During the next two weeks our school buildings will be closed to the public so that thorough cleaning measures can take place. Our custodial crews are concentrating on disinfecting surfaces that are most commonly touched (door handles, table and desk tops, railings, etc.). All classroom surfaces, including desks, will be disinfected, as well as all common areas, lockers and playground equipment. The deep clean of our schools will be done with bleach solutions, peroxide cleaners, and disinfecting wipes.

In the course of the two week period, when students are not in district, we will continue to develop our distance learning plan. Thank you to all that have already completed our [Device and Wi-Fi Survey](#). Should closure extend beyond March 27th we would initiate our teaching and learning plan. We will keep you informed as this evolves.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as we work through this incredibly challenging time.
