Dear Parents, Guardians, and Simsbury Public Schools Staff:

The district was notified today of a student in the Simsbury High School community who has tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last in school on Tuesday, October 20. In following our protocol, we immediately contacted the Farmington Valley Health District to collaboratively assess the case. Since the individual has not been in school for two weeks, and school is closed tomorrow for Election Day, the Farmington Valley Health District has advised us that there is no need to implement our typical contact tracing protocols, nor further quarantine anyone in the building.

As a reminder, it is imperative that parents, guardians, and staff complete daily health assessments before coming to school. Should anyone feel ill, please stay home. Further, should anyone in our school community test positive for COVID-19 or come in close contact with someone who has, it is critical for everyone's health and safety to inform your school nurse immediately.
