

Directions for Converting MP4 Extension/Video Format

When you use the **FLIP** to record video, the camera saves with the extension/video format of MP4. You cannot use **Windows Movie Maker** to edit your movie without converting the movie to a WMV extension/video format. The directions below allow you to convert from the MP4 extension/video format to a WMV extension/video format using **Real Player Converter**. To locate and use:

Click on **Start**
Click on **All Programs**
Locate **Real**
Click on **Real Player Converter**

When Real Player Converter opens
Click on **Add**
Locate the **MP4 file** you saved
Click, then open the MP4

Locate the **Convert to** menu.
Scroll and select desired extension/video format.
(Save as a WMV extension if you wish to edit using Windows MovieMaker.)
Click **OK**

Locate the **Save In** menu. Use the Drop-down menu to locate where you want the converted file saved.
Click **Start** button

You can now open Movie Maker and import the wmv extension/video format to make necessary edits to your movie.
